Subtitle of House Bill No. 1547

TO PROHIBIT MANDATORY COVID-19 IMMUNIZATIONS OR VACCINATIONS FOR STUDENTS AND
EMPLOYEES AND A REQUIREMENT FOR A VACCINATION OR IMMUNIZATION FOR COVID-19
EXCEPT IN CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1547

Amend House Bill No. 1547 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 8 and 9, and substitute the following:

"(B) Subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section shall expire on either:

(i) Four (4) years from the effective date of this act if the immunization or vaccination for coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) was been approved under emergency use authorization; or

(ii) Two (2) years from the date that the United States Food and Drug Administration approves the immunization or vaccination for coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) outside of an emergency use authorization."

AND

Page 3, line 27, delete "(5)" and substitute "(5)(A)"

AND

Page 4, delete lines 5 and 6, and substitute the following:

"This subchapter shall expire on either:

(1) Four (4) years from the effective date of this act if the immunization or vaccination for coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) was been approved under emergency use authorization; or

(2) Two (2) years from the date that the United States Food and Drug Administration approves the immunization or vaccination for coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) outside of an emergency use authorization."

AND

Page 6, delete lines 25 and 26, and substitute the following:

"(b) Subdivision (a)(2)(A)(iii)(a) of this section shall expire on either:



(1) Four (4) years from the effective date of this act if the immunization or vaccination for coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) was been approved under emergency use authorization; or

(2) Two (2) years from the date that the United States Food and Drug Administration approves the immunization or vaccination for coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) outside of an emergency use authorization."
