**Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1777**

Amend House Bill No. 1777 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 8, delete "VICTIMS VOTER" and substitute "VICTIMS' VOTER"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following:

"TO PROTECT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIMS'  
VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION; TO AMEND  
THE DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE; AND  
TO AMEND ARKANSAS ELECTION PROCEDURE."

AND

Add Senators B. Davis, Hester as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Page 1, delete line 29, and substitute the following:

"not reproduce any address of a secure voter in any"

AND

Page 1, line 36, delete "except the list of" and substitute "except"

AND

Page 2, line 36, delete "(c) The" and substitute "(c) Any"

AND

Page 3, line 12, delete "maintain the" and substitute "maintain any"



AND

Page 3, line 13, delete "residential address" and substitute "address"

AND

Page 3, delete line 16, and substitute the following:

"involving a secure voter.

(e) As used in §§ 7-5-109 and 7-5-110 and this section, "secure voter" means a registered voter who requests to have his or her address or addresses protected from public release and is a domestic violence victim who:

(1) Is the victim of any offense under § 5-26-301 et seq. as adjudicated by a court;

(2) Has been granted an order of protection under the Domestic Abuse Act of 1991, § 9-15-101 et seq.; or

(3) Is recognized as a victim of domestic violence in any court order or ruling."
