19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 92, Subchapter 3 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 17-92-317. (a) If a pharmacist acquires, during any given calendar
24 year, approved continuing education hours in excess of the minimum hours
25 required by the Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy, the excess credit shall be
26 carried forward and applied to the education requirement for the succeeding
27 year only.

28 (b) The maximum number of continuing education hours one may carry
29 forward shall be equal to the minimum annual hours required by the board.
