14 AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO USE SPERM,  
15 OVA OR EMBRYOS FOR ANY PURPOSE NOT  
16 CONSENTED TO BY THE PROVIDER.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. (a) It is unlawful for anyone to knowingly use sperm, ova,  
22 or embryos, in assisted reproduction technology, for any purpose other than  
23 the purpose that is indicated in a written consent form signed by the sperm,  
24 ova, or embryo provider.

25 (b) It is unlawful for anyone to knowingly implant sperm, ova, or  
26 embryos, through the use of assisted reproduction technology, into a recipient  
27 who is not the sperm, ova, or embryo provider, without a written consent form  
28 signed by the sperm, ova, or embryo provider and recipient.

29 (c) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class D  
30 felony.
