21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
22 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
23 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the
26 Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the
27 electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election
28 for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon
29 at such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the
30 Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Section 2 of Amendment 73 to the Arkansas
33 Constitution is amended to read as follows:

34 (a) The Arkansas House of Representatives shall consist of members to
35 be chosen every second year by the qualified electors of the several counties.
36 No member of the Arkansas House of Representatives may serve more than ~~three~~

1 four such two year terms.

3 SECTION 2. This amendment becomes effective on January 1, 2005.
