8 HOUSE RESOLUTION

9 COMMENDING ARKANSAS FARMERS FOR THEIR VITAL
10 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE SECURITY AND ECONOMIC WELL-BEING

20 WHEREAS, twenty-five percent (25%) of Arkansas' economy is based on
21 food, fiber and forestry; and two-thirds (2/3) of Arkansas' counties rely
22 primarily on farming and forestry as their industrial base; and

24 WHEREAS, agriculture and related activities and industries employ one
25 (1) in four (4) Arkansans; and

27 WHEREAS, agricultural pursuits in this state produce wealth in excess of
28 six billion dollars (\$6,000,000,000) annually and contribute immeasurably to
29 Arkansas' stable and well-balanced economy; and

31 WHEREAS, farmers, ranchers and foresters provide the bulk of the state's
32 wildlife habitat, practice sound environmental stewardship, and supply
33 community leadership throughout rural Arkansas; and

35 WHEREAS, the agricultural community contributes a substantial portion of
36 the revenues which finance state and local services to all this state's

3 WHEREAS, Arkansas farmers, ranchers and foresters are deserving of
4 public commendation and appreciation,

6 NOW THEREFORE,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
8 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

10 That the Arkansas House of Representatives hereby expresses sincere
11 appreciation to Arkansas farmers for their outstanding contributions to the
12 economy of the state and nation and to the well-being of the people, and
13 commend them for their dedication to the wise utilization of our resources.
