10 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 3-4-206 TO PROHIBIT  
11 FUTURE LIQUOR STORES FROM BEING LOCATED WITHIN 1,000

15 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 3-4-206 TO  
16 PROHIBIT FUTURE LIQUOR STORES FROM BEING  
17 LOCATED WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF A CHURCH OR

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 3-4-206 is amended to read as follows:

24 3-4-206. Operation of retail liquor business within 200 yards of church  
25 or school house prohibited.

26 (a) No new permit to engage in the retail liquor business in this state  
27 shall be issued by the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division for  
28 the location of any business situated within two hundred (200) yards of any  
29 church or school house.

30 (b) However, after the effective date of this subsection:

31 (1) No new permit to engage in the retail liquor business in this  
32 state may be issued by the director for the location of any business situated  
33 within one thousand feet (1,000') of any church or school house; and

34 (2) No existing permit to engage in the retail liquor business in  
35 this state may be transferred to a location within one thousand feet (1,000')  
36 of any church or school house.

1           (3) As an exception to subdivision (2) of this subsection, if any  
2 retail liquor business in this state already exists within one thousand feet  
3 (1,000') of one or more churches or schoolhouses then that same retail liquor  
4 store may be allowed to transfer to a new location that is within one thousand  
5 feet (1,000') of the closest church or schoolhouse to the present liquor store  
6 location if the new location is determined by the Alcoholic Beverage Control  
7 Division to serve the public convenience and advantage.
