For An Act To Be Entitled

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10 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT
11 OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING
12 OFFICER FOR STATE ASSISTANCE TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS
13 IN LOGAN COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES.

Subtitle

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18 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
19 AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER
20 - STATE ASSISTANCE TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS
21 IN LOGAN COUNTY, ARKANSAS GENERAL
22 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.

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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN LOGAN COUNTY. There is
28 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
29 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
30 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

31 (A) For state assistance to the Scranton Rural Fire Department for
32 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

33 (B) For state assistance to the Subiaco/Crossroads Fire Department for
34 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

35 (C) For state assistance to the Driggs Rural Fire Department for
36 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.



1 (D) For state assistance to the Roseville Rural Fire Department for
2 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

3 (E) For state assistance to the Magazine City/Rural Fire Department for
4 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

5 (F) For state assistance to the Grayson Rural Fire Department for
6 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

7 (G) For state assistance to the Ione Community Fire Department for
8 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

9 (H) For state assistance to the Ratcliff City/Rural Fire Department for
10 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

11 (I) For state assistance to the Booneville City Fire Department for
12 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

13 (J) For state assistance to the Paris City Fire Department for equipment,
14 the sum of\$4,000.

15 (K) For state assistance to the Golden City Volunteer Fire Department for
16 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

17 (L) For state assistance to the Booneville Rural Fire Department for
18 equipment, the sum of\$4,000.

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20 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
21 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
22 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
23 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
24 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
25 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
26 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
27 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
28 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
29 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
30 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
31 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

32 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
33 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
34 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
35 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
36 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any

1 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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3 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
5 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
6 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
7 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
9 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
10 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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12 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
19 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
