19 7 through March 11 for National Young Voter's Month activities; and

22 be gathering at the State Capitol to learn about the history of Arkansas
23 suffrage; and

25 WHEREAS, the participation of persons eighteen to twenty-four (18-24)
26 years of age in the voting process is in decline; and

28 WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of state and community leaders to
29 reverse the decline in voting by persons eighteen to twenty-four (18-24)
