25 held the Arkansas Senior Olympic record for his age group and was even ranked
26 the second-fastest runner in his age group at the United States Senior
27 Olympics; and

29 WHEREAS, on January 29, 2005, Al Davis, Sr., at the age of eighty-seven
30 (87) years was inducted into the Arkansas Runners Hall of Fame in recognition
31 of his many running awards, sportsmanship, and positive influence in the
32 sport of running; and

34 WHEREAS, Al Davis, Sr., will compete this summer in his third straight
35 National Olympics being held in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and
