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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-52-401, concerning exemptions from the
28 tax imposed by the Arkansas Gross Receipts Act of 1941, § 26-52-101 et seq.,
29 is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

30 (39) Gross receipts or gross proceeds derived from sales of tangible
31 personal property or services to the Arkansas Emergency Medical Technician
32 Association, Inc., the Arkansas Emergency Medical Foundation, Inc., and the
33 Arkansas Ambulance Association, Inc.
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35 SECTION 2. Effective date. Section 1 of this act is effective on the
36 first day of the calendar month following the effective date of this act.
