13 AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE MEMBERS OF
14 THE BOARD OF THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF
15 NURSING.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-87-201 is amended to read as follows:
22 17-87-201. Creation – Members.

23 (a) There is created the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, to be
24 composed of thirteen (13) members to be appointed by the Governor for terms
25 of four (4) years, subject to confirmation by the Senate.

26 (b)(1) Six (6) members shall be registered nurses whose highest level
27 of educational preparation shall be as follows:

28 (A) Two (2) diploma-school graduates;

29 (B) Two (2) associate degree graduates; and

30 (C) Two (2) baccalaureate degree or postbaccalaureate
31 degree graduates.

32 (2) Each registered nurse member of the board shall have the
33 following qualifications:

34 (A) Be an Arkansas resident;

35 (B) Have at least five (5) years of successful experience
36 as a registered nurse in nursing practice, administration, or teaching;



- 1 (C) Be licensed in Arkansas as a registered nurse; and
- 2 (D) Have been employed as a registered nurse for at least
- 3 three (3) years immediately preceding appointment, two (2) of which shall
- 4 have been in Arkansas.

5 (c)(1) One (1) member shall be a licensed advanced practice nurse.

6 (2) The licensed advanced practice nurse board member shall have

7 the following qualifications:

- 8 (A) Be an Arkansas resident;
- 9 (B) Have at least five (5) years of experience as an
- 10 advanced practice nurse;
- 11 (C) Be licensed in Arkansas as an advanced practice nurse;
- 12 (D) Have been actively engaged in nursing for at least
- 13 three (3) years immediately preceding appointment, two (2) of which shall
- 14 have been in Arkansas; and
- 15 (E) Have a certificate granting prescriptive authority.

16 (d)(1) ~~Three (3)~~ Four (4) members shall be licensed practical nurses

17 or licensed psychiatric technician nurses.

18 (2) Each licensed practical nurse board member or licensed

19 psychiatric technician nurse board member shall have the following

20 qualifications:

- 21 (A) Be an Arkansas resident;
- 22 (B) Have at least five (5) years of successful experience
- 23 as a practical nurse or psychiatric technician nurse or as a teacher in an
- 24 educational program to prepare practitioners of nursing;
- 25 (C) Be licensed in Arkansas as a licensed practical nurse
- 26 or licensed psychiatric technician nurse; and
- 27 (D) Have been employed as a licensed practical nurse or as
- 28 a licensed psychiatric technician nurse for at least three (3) years
- 29 immediately preceding appointment, two (2) of which shall have been in
- 30 Arkansas.

32 ~~(2) Each licensed psychiatric technician nurse board member shall~~

- 34 ~~(A) Be an Arkansas resident;~~

2 ~~(C) Be licensed in Arkansas as a licensed psychiatric~~

4 ~~(D) Have been actively engaged in nursing as a licensed~~
5 ~~psychiatric technician nurse for at least three (3) years immediately~~
6 ~~preceding appointment, two (2) of which shall have been in Arkansas.~~

7 ~~(f)(e)~~ One (1) member shall be a lay person representing consumers of
8 health care services.

9 ~~(g)(f)~~ One (1) member of the board shall not be actively engaged in or
10 retired from the profession of nursing, shall be sixty (60) years of age or
11 older, and shall be the representative of the elderly. This member shall be
12 appointed from the state at large, subject to confirmation by the Senate, and
13 shall be a full voting member but shall not participate in the grading of
14 examinations.

15 ~~(h)(g)~~ The consumer representative and the representative of the
16 elderly positions may not be filled by the same person.

17 ~~(i)(h)~~ No member shall be appointed to more than two (2) consecutive
18 terms.

19 ~~(j)(i)~~ Board members may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in
20 accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.

21 ~~(k)(j)~~ ~~In order to effectuate a more even staggering of the terms of~~
22 ~~nurse members of the board, the term of one (1) of the registered nurses~~
23 ~~whose term will expire on October 1, 1999, is extended to October 1, 2001,~~
24 ~~and the term of the advanced practice nurse whose term will expired on~~
25 ~~October 1, 1999, is extended to October 1, 2002. The Governor shall~~
26 ~~designate the registered nurse whose term is to be extended pursuant to this~~
27 ~~subsection. Thereafter, the The terms of all registered nurse members and~~
28 advanced practice nurse members shall be four (4) years.

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
