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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-21-403 is amended to read as follows:
22 6-21-403. Requirements generally.

23 (a) Public school districts shall provide textbooks and other
24 instructional materials for all pupils attending the public schools of this
25 state in grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12), inclusive, in all
26 subjects taught in those grades, without cost to the pupils.

27 (b) School districts may select their own textbooks or instructional
28 materials, or districts may select from the recommended state-approved list.

29 (c) Any materials purchased with state funds shall be consistent with
30 the curriculum and educational goals established by the State Board of
31 Education.

32 (d)(1) The Department of Education shall monitor public school
33 districts to ensure compliance with this section.

34 (2) The state board may promulgate rules necessary to ensure
35 compliance with this section.

36 (e) On or before November 1 of each year, the department shall report



to the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education all public school districts that have not complied with this section.

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
