21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-95-101(b), concerning civil immunity of
24 a person who is not trained or skilled in the treatment of medical
25 emergencies for rendering emergency medical services at an emergency or
26 accident scene, is amended to read as follows:

27 (b) Any person who is not a physician, surgeon, nurse, or other person
28 trained or skilled in the treatment of medical emergencies who is present at
29 an emergency or accident scene, and who:

30 (1) Believes that the life, health, and safety of an injured
31 person or a person who is under imminent threat of danger could be aided by
32 reasonable and accessible emergency procedures under the circumstances
33 existing at the scene thereof;

34 (2) Proceeds to lend emergency assistance or service in a manner
35 reasonably calculated to lessen or remove the immediate threat to the life,
36 health, or safety of such a person;
