26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend provisions of the
29 Arkansas Code concerning the prevention of human immunodeficiency virus
30 (HIV), to reduce the spread of the communicable disease of human
31 immunodeficiency virus (HIV) to children and family members, and to require a
32 blood test prior to the issuance of a marriage license.
