18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16 is amended to add an additional  
21 chapter to read as follows:

22 Chapter 24. Court Bailiffs.

23 Subchapter 1 – General Provisions

24 16-24-101. Oaths for court bailiffs.

25 (a) The following oath, in substance, shall be administered to a court  
26 bailiff at the start of a jury trial:

27 "I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will faithfully, impartially,  
28 and to the best of my ability, discharge the duties of bailiff of this court,  
29 to which office I have been appointed, and strictly obey all orders of the  
30 court, as bailiff during the present session now being held."

31 (b) The following oath, in substance, shall be administered to a court  
32 bailiff prior to the deliberation of a jury:

33 "I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will keep this jury together,  
34 not allowing any person to speak to them or overhear their deliberations, nor  
35 to speak to them myself, unless it is in the performance of my official  
36 duties as bailiff to this court."
