24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, is amended to add an
27 additional subchapter to read as follows:

29 Subchapter 6 – Textbooks and course materials

30 6-60-601. Textbook royalties.

31 (a) A state-supported institution of higher education shall establish
32 guidelines for the use of royalties received by a faculty member from the
33 sale of textbooks and course materials for classes taught by the faculty
34 member.
