21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-415(a), concerning the proceeds
24 derived from the sale of confiscated goods, is amended to read as follows:

25 (a)(1)(A) In all cities and towns, all goods confiscated by a police
26 officer of the city, by the sheriff, or by an officer of the Department of
27 Arkansas State Police within the city and that are no longer needed as
28 evidence shall be sold at auction or Internet auction.

29 (B) The auction or Internet auction shall be held at least
30 annually or more often if the city determines appropriate, ~~and~~.

31 (C) ~~the~~ The proceeds derived from the sale of all
32 confiscated goods shall be deposited into the city's policemen's pension and
33 ~~retirement~~ relief fund.

34 (2) Subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall not supercede any
35 existing provisions of law governing the disposition of confiscated goods.
