15 TO ALLOW MONEYS DEPOSITED INTO THE  
16 DISTRICT COURT AUTOMATION FUND TO BE

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-13-704(b)(3)(B)(i) [Effective until  
24 January 1, 2012.], concerning the district court automation fund, is amended  
25 to read as follows:

26 (B)(i) The other half of the installment fee collected in  
27 district court shall be remitted by the tenth day of each month to the city  
28 treasurer of the city in which the district court is located to be deposited  
29 ~~in~~ into a fund entitled the "district court automation fund" to be used  
30 ~~solely first~~ for district court-related technology and then to be used for  
31 technology related to law enforcement management and operations.

33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-13-704(b)(3)(B) [Effective January 1,  
34 2012.], concerning the district court automation fund, is amended to read as  
35 follows:
