9 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

10 TO PROVIDE FOR RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH
11 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON
12 APRIL 10, 2009; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF
13 THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
14 ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON, MAY 1, 2009; TO
15 AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE
16 AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,
17 BY JOINT PROCLAMATION, TO RECONVENE THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MAY 1,
19 2009, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,
20 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, COMPLETING ITS
21 WORK ON PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS,
22 CONSIDERING ANY ISSUES THAT MAY ARISE FROM THE
23 PASSAGE OF THE FEDERAL STIMULUS PACKAGE, AND
24 CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE
25 REGULAR SESSION OR TO ADJOURN THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH
26 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT DATE IF
27 THEY DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO
28 RECONVENE; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL
29 ASSEMBLY IS NOT RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE
30 12:00 NOON, MAY 1, 2009, THE REGULAR SESSION OF
31 THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED
32 SINE DIE ON THAT DATE.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
6 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
7

8 (a) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-Seventh General Assembly of
9 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, May 1, 2009;

10 (b) That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, prior to
11 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five days after
12 receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill, therefore from April 10,
13 2009 to May 1, 2009, the House Representatives and the Senate shall be open
14 so the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the
15 office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications, vetoes of
16 bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights;

17 (c) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-Seventh General Assembly of
18 the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess simultaneously at the close of
19 business in each chamber on April 10, 2009, or at such earlier time as may be
20 agreed upon by the House of Representatives and the Senate;

21 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President
22 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

23 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00
24 noon, May 1, 2009, for the purpose of:

25 (A) Considering vetoes;

26 (B) Correcting errors and oversights;

27 (C) Completing its work on proposed constitutional
28 amendments;

29 (D) Considering any issues that may arise from the passage
30 of the federal stimulus package; and

31 (E) Considering the need for further extension of the
32 Regular Session of the Eighty-Seventh General Assembly; or

33 (2) Adjourn the Regular Session of the Eighty-Seventh General
34 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, May 1, 2009, if they determine it is
35 not necessary to reconvene; and

36 (e) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before

1 12:00 noon, May 1, 2009, the Regular Session of the Eighty-Seventh General
2 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date.
