## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO PROMOTE FAIRNESS BY CLARIFYING THE  
10 BENEFITS FOR PILOT COURT DISTRICT JUDGES ELECTED  
11 PRIOR TO JULY 1, 1999; TO ALLOW SERVICE TO BE  
12 CREDITED AT TWO TIME THE REGUALR RATE IN THE  
13 COMPUTATION OF BENEFITS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO CLARIFY THE BENEFITS FOR PILOT COURT  
16 DISTRICT JUDGES ELECTED PRIOR TO JULY 1,  
17 1999.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-4-521(b), concerning the amount of  
24 service to be credited to its members, is amended to add an additional  
25 subdivision to read as follows:

26 (7)(A) A pilot court district judge who is classified as a full-  
27 time state judge under § 16-17-1101 et seq. and who was first elected  
28 into non-contributory employment in the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement  
29 System as an elected local public official prior to July 1, 1999, shall be  
30 credited with service at two (2) times the regular rate for crediting  
31 service.

32 (B) A pilot court district judge who was first elected as  
33 a municipal judge after July 1, 1999, and who was already in office serving  
34 as a municipal judge in the elected local public official division of the  
35 Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System prior to July 1, 2001, shall be  
36 credited with service at two (2) times the regular rate for crediting
