14 AN ACT CONCERNING SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-64-401(c), concerning penalties for  
22 possession of a controlled or counterfeit substance, is amended to read as  
23 follows:

24 (c) Possession of Counterfeit or Controlled Substance.

25 (1) It is unlawful for any person to possess a controlled  
26 substance or counterfeit substance unless the controlled substance or  
27 counterfeit substance was obtained:

28 (A) Directly from or pursuant to a valid prescription or  
29 an order of a practitioner while acting in the course of his or her  
30 professional practice; or

31 (B) As otherwise authorized by this chapter.

32 (2) Any person who violates this subsection with respect to:

33 (A) A controlled substance classified in Schedule I or  
34 Schedule II is guilty of a Class C felony;

35 (B) Any other controlled substance, first offense, is  
36 guilty of a Class A misdemeanor;



1 (C) Any other controlled substance, second offense, is  
2 guilty of a Class D felony; and

3 (D) Any other controlled substance, third or subsequent  
4 offense, is guilty of a Class C felony.

5 (3) For purposes of this subsection, an offense is considered a  
6 second or subsequent offense if, before his or her conviction for the  
7 offense, the person has been convicted for an offense under this subsection  
8 (c) or under any equivalent penal statute of the United States or of any  
9 state.
