22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. (a) Effective January 1, 2011, the offices of sheriff and
25 tax collector in Monroe County, Arkansas, shall be separate offices.

26 (b) Effective January 1, 2011, the offices of tax collector and
27 treasurer shall be consolidated into one (1) office.

28 (c) At the 2010 general election, the qualified electors of Monroe
29 County shall elect a sheriff and a tax collector-treasurer, and each officer
30 so elected shall take office on January 1, 2011.

31 (d) The sheriff and tax collector-treasurer in Monroe County shall
32 each give bond for the faithful performance of their duties as is provided by
33 law.

34
35 SECTION 2. The sheriff and tax collector-treasurer of Monroe County
36 shall each receive compensation as shall be determined by the Monroe County



1 Quorum Court within the minimum and maximum compensation range prescribed by
2 the General Assembly, and shall hire deputies and have other allowances as
3 prescribed by the Monroe County Quorum Court.
