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15 TO CORRECT A CODIFICATION ERROR IN TITLE
16 23 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-18-517(a), concerning parties to
23 certification proceedings, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a) The parties to a certification proceeding shall include:

25 (1) The applicant;

26 (2) Each municipality, county, and government agency or
27 department or other person entitled to receive service of a copy of the
28 application under § 23-18-513(a) and (b) if it has filed with the Arkansas
29 Public Service Commission a notice of intervention as a party within thirty
30 (30) days after service; or

31 (3) Any person residing in a municipality or county which is
32 entitled to receive service of a copy of the application under § 23-18-513(a)
33 and (b) ~~or~~ or

34 ~~(4) Any~~ any domestic nonprofit corporation, formed in whole or
35 in part to promote conservation or natural beauty, to promote energy
36 conservation, to protect the environment, personal health, or other



1 biological values, to represent commercial and industrial groups, or to
2 promote the orderly development of the areas in which the facility is to be
3 located, where a such person or organization has an interest which may be
4 directly affected by the commission's action and which interest is not
5 adequately represented by other parties, if such a person or corporation has
6 petitioned the commission for leave to intervene as a party within thirty
7 (30) days after the date given in the public notice as the date of filing the
8 application.

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10 SECTION 2. The enactment and adoption of this act shall not repeal,
11 expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular session of the 87th
12 General Assembly. All such acts shall have full effect and, so far as those
13 acts intentionally vary from or conflict with any provision contained in this
14 act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or
15 repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
