17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 9, Chapter 12, Subchapter 3 is amended
20 to add an additional section to read as follows:

21 9-12-326 Ex parte orders.

22 In an ex parte hearing for relief incidental to, or after a proceeding
23 for divorce, including but not limited to petitions for spousal support,
24 child custody, visitation rights, child support, injunctive relief, and the
25 division, possession, and use of joint property, the resulting order shall be
26 null and void unless a hearing is held with both parties present within
27 fourteen (14) days of the entry of the order.
