For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
9 ARKANSAS STATE POLICE REGARDING USED MOTOR VEHICLE
10 DEALERS; TO CLARIFY THAT A DESIGNATED EMPLOYEE OF THE
11 DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE MAY INSPECT
12 RECORDS OF USED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES.

Subtitle

17 TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE
18 DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE
19 REGARDING USED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-112-604 is amended to read as follows:

25 23-112-604. ~~Power to promulgate rules and regulations~~ Powers
26 generally.

27 (a) The Department of Arkansas State Police ~~shall have the power to~~
28 may promulgate such rules and regulations as that are necessary to implement,
29 enforce, and administer this subchapter.

30 (b) The department may cancel a dealer's license if the ~~respective~~
31 dealer:

32 (1) ~~fails~~ Fails to keep and maintain the requirements ~~set forth~~
33 in of § 23-112-607(a) and ~~(b)~~ (c); or

34 (2) ~~upon conviction~~ Pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or has
35 been found guilty of a ~~third~~ violation of ~~this subchapter~~ § 23-112-605.



1 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-112-611(b), concerning records to be
2 maintained by used motor vehicle dealers, is amended to read as follows:

3 (b) Dealers shall maintain copies of all documents executed in
4 conjunction with any transaction, which may include bills of sale, titles,
5 odometer statements, invoices, affidavits of alteration, and reassignments,
6 and shall be open to inspection to any Department of Arkansas State Police
7 officer or designated employee of the department acting in an official
8 capacity during reasonable business hours.
