18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-16-705(a), regarding the Attorney
21 General's subpoena power, is amended to read as follows:

22 (a) In all litigation, including criminal matters, in which the
23 interests of the State of Arkansas are involved or may become involved,
24 before any tribunal, board, or commission, the Attorney General shall have
25 the right to subpoena any person or the books, records, or other documents
26 being held by any person. He or she shall have the authority to administer
27 oaths for the purpose of taking testimony of witnesses subpoenaed before him
28 or her, which he or she may deem necessary to adequately present the state's
29 case.
