SENATE BILL 724

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT CONCERNING VOLUNTARY SALARY REDUCTIONS BY
9 CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AND STATE EMPLOYEES; AND FOR
10 OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

14 CONCERNING VOLUNTARY SALARY REDUCTIONS BY
15 CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AND STATE
16 EMPLOYEES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 1, Subchapter 4 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 21-1-409. Donation of constitutional officer's salary to General
24 Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund.

25 (a) A constitutional officer may donate all or a portion of his or her
26 salary to the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund.

27 (b) A constitutional officer who chooses to donate all or a portion of
28 his or her salary to the fund account shall make a written request to the
29 Department of Finance and Administration at least thirty (30) days before the
30 beginning of a fiscal year. The request shall:

31 (1) Specify the amount of salary the constitutional officer
32 intends to donate to the fund account; and

33 (2) Apply to the fiscal year following the date of the request.

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 5, Subchapter 2 is amended
36 to add an additional section to read as follows:



1 21-5-226. Decline of salary increase by employee.

2 (a) An employee may decline a salary increase.

3 (b) An employee who chooses to decline a salary increase shall make a
4 written request to his or her supervisor:

5 (1) Before the salary increase takes effect; or

6 (2) Within fourteen (14) days of the taking effect of the salary
7 increase.

8 (c) The salary of an employee who declines a salary increase shall be
9 adjusted to the amount preceding the proposed salary increase.
