17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-7-305(c)(1), regarding the ballot form
20 for a judicial election, is amended to read as follows:

21 (c)(1)(A) Any person who shall file for any elective office in this
22 state may use not more than three (3) given names, one (1) of which may be a
23 nickname or any other word used for the purpose of identifying the person to
24 the voters, and may add as a prefix to his or her name the title or an
25 abbreviation of an elective public office the person currently holds.

26 (B) A person may only use as the prefix the title of a
27 judicial office in an election for a judgeship if the person is currently
28 serving in a judicial position ~~to which the person has been elected~~ in which
29 the person has served for no less than twelve (12) months prior to filing for
30 the position.

31 (C) A nickname shall not include a professional or
32 honorary title.
