8 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER
9 EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH A FORMULA FOR DETERMINING
10 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNTS UNDER THE ARKANSAS ACADEMIC
11 CHALLENGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM -- PART 2; TO ENHANCE
12 THE STABILITY OF FUNDING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS WITH NET
13 PROCEEDS FROM THE STATE LOTTERY; TO DECLARE AN
14 EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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18 ARKANSAS ACADEMIC CHALLENGE SCHOLARSHIP
19 AWARD STABILIZATION ACT.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-85-212(e)(1), concerning scholarship
25 awards for the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 2, is
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (e)(1)(A) The scholarship award amount under this subchapter for an
28 academic year for a full-time recipient enrolled in a four-year approved
29 institution of higher education ~~is five thousand dollars (\$5,000)~~ shall be
30 calculated by the Department of Higher Education using the formula under § 6-
31 85-221.

32 ~~(B)(i) The Department of Higher Education shall award an~~
33 ~~aggregate amount of scholarship awards to current achiever students beginning~~
34 ~~with the 2010-2011 academic year of up to forty one million five hundred~~
35 ~~thousand dollars (\$41,500,000).~~

36 ~~(ii) The department shall not accept new~~



1 applications from current achiever students for scholarships under this
2 subdivision (e)(1)(B) after June 1, 2012.

3 ~~(C) After deducting the amount committed for current~~
4 ~~achiever student scholarships from the amount available under subdivision~~
5 ~~(e)(1)(B) of this section, the department shall use the balance to fund~~
6 ~~scholarships to nontraditional students under this subchapter.~~

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8 SECTION 2. Arkansas Title 6, Chapter 85, Subchapter 2, is amended to
9 add an additional section to read as follows:

10 6-85-221. Formula for determining scholarship award amounts.

11 (a) Annually by May 31, the Department of Higher Education shall
12 determine the scholarship award amount for full-time scholarship recipients
13 attending a four-year approved institution of higher education under this
14 subchapter calculated using the assumptions and formula under this section.

15 (b)(1) The Department of Higher Education shall use the following
16 method to project the number of eligible traditional student applicants:

17 (A) The Department of Higher Education shall obtain from
18 the Department of Education the number of high school students who are
19 anticipated to graduate high school with the requirements of § 6-85-207;

20 (B) The projected number of traditional students under
21 subdivision (b)(1)(A) shall be multiplied by the percentage of traditional
22 students who received the scholarship in the previous academic year and
23 attended a four-year approved institution of higher education;

24 (C) The projected number of traditional students under
25 subdivision (b)(1)(A) shall be multiplied by the percentage of traditional
26 students who received the scholarship in the previous academic year and
27 attended a two-year approved institution of higher education.

28 (D) The number of nursing students shall be projected as
29 the same number receiving a scholarship under this subchapter for the
30 previous year.

31 (E) The sum of the number of students under subdivisions
32 (b)(1)(B) - (D) of this section shall be increased by an annual growth factor
33 of one percent (1%).

34 (F) A dropout rate shall be applied to the number of
35 students under subdivision (b)(1)(E) of this section as follows:

36 (i) Thirty-five percent (35%) of students who

1 received the scholarship for the previous academic year;

2 (ii) Ten percent (10%) of students who have received
3 the scholarship for two (2) previous years; and

4 (iii) Ten percent (10%) of students have received
5 the scholarship for the previous three (3) academic years.

6 (2) The number of current achiever students shall be projected
7 at the number of current achiever students receiving the scholarship for the
8 previous academic year, less those who are no longer eligible for the
9 scholarship.

10 (3) The number of nontraditional students is not calculated as
11 long as the aggregate award amount is an amount set by statute.

12 (5) The number of students receiving a scholarship award under
13 the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 1, § 6-85-101 et
14 seq., shall be projected at the number of current recipients for the previous
15 academic year, less those who are no longer eligible for the scholarship.

16 (c) The Department of Higher Education shall calculate the amount of
17 funding available for scholarship awards for one (1) academic year as:

18 (1) The sum of net proceeds from the lottery for the twelve (12)
19 months beginning May 1 of the immediately preceding calendar year through
20 April 30 of the current calendar year;

21 (2) The amount of any balance of net proceeds from the lottery
22 carried forward from the previous year; plus

23 (3) The amount of nonlottery educational resources allocated to
24 the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Parts 1 and 2.

25 (d) The scholarship award amount for a traditional student attending a
26 four-year approved institution of higher education shall be an amount equal
27 to:

28 (A) The sum of:

29 (i) The total amount of available funding calculated
30 under subsection (c) of this section; less

31 (ii) The amount of funding under § 6-85-212 for
32 nontraditional students; less

33 (iii) The amount of scholarship awards under the
34 Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 1 multiplied by the
35 number of projected recipients calculated under subdivision (b)(4) of this
36 section; less

1 (iv) The amount of twenty million dollars
2 (\$20,000,000) to be maintained as a balance; divided by

3 (B) The total number of students calculated under
4 subdivisions (b)(1)-(3) of this section.

5 (e)(1) The Department of Higher Education may annually adjust the
6 assumptions for annual growth rate under subdivision (b)(1)(D) of this
7 section and dropout rate under subdivision (b)(1)(E) of this section based on
8 actual updated data.

9 (2) The Department of Higher Education shall provide a thirty-
10 day notice to the Arkansas Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee
11 before making any adjustments to the dropout rate or other assumptions under
12 this formula.

13 (3) Annually by May 1, the Department of Higher Education shall
14 provide to the committee all of the underlying assumptions the Department of
15 Higher Education will use to make the calculations under this section.

16 (f)(1) Annually by June 1, the Department of Higher Education shall:

17 (A) Publish a notice of the scholarship award amount on
18 its website in a manner easily accessible to the public; and

19 (B) Provide notice to the committee of the scholarship
20 award amount and a detailed calculation of the anticipated scholarship award
21 amounts for:

22 (i) Traditional students, current achiever students,
23 nontraditional students, and nursing students receiving scholarships under
24 the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 2; and

25 (ii) Students receiving scholarships under the
26 Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 1.

27 (2) Annually by October 31 and March 31, the Department of
28 Higher Education shall provide a written report to the committee on the
29 aggregate scholarship awards to each institution of higher education for the
30 applicable term.

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32 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-115-403(g), concerning unclaimed lottery
33 prize money, is amended to read as follows:

34 (g)(1) ~~Unclaimed lottery prize money shall be added to net lottery~~
35 ~~proceeds~~ During a fiscal year, the commission may expend up to two million
36 five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) of unclaimed lottery prize money

1 for one (1) or more of the following:

2 (A) Increasing the pool from which future lottery prizes
3 are to be awarded;

4 (B) Maintaining online game reserves at a fiscally sound
5 level; or

6 (C) Prize promotion.

7 (2) On the last day of each fiscal year, the commission shall
8 deposit into the trust account for net lottery proceeds the amount of
9 unclaimed lottery prize money existing at the end of the fiscal year less one
10 million dollars (\$1,000,000).

11 (3) The commission shall include in its monthly reports to the
12 Arkansas Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee the following
13 monthly and year-to-date amounts:

14 (A) Unclaimed lottery prize money;

15 (B) Expenditures from unclaimed lottery prize money; and

16 (C) Deposits to net lottery proceeds from unclaimed
17 lottery prize money.

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19 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that increasing the number of
21 Arkansans who obtain postsecondary credentials is critical to the economic
22 health of the state and its citizens; that the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery
23 provides the opportunity for tens of thousands of Arkansans to obtain
24 postsecondary education; that the deadline for scholarship applications is
25 June 1; that the financial integrity of the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery is
26 critical to the continued existence of the scholarships; and that this act is
27 immediately necessary for the Department of Higher Education to promulgate
28 rules to implement this act well before June 1, 2011, in order to provide
29 eligible Arkansans the opportunity to apply for the scholarship. Therefore,
30 an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary
31 for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
32 effective on:

33 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

34 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
35 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
36 bill; or

1 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
2 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
