17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §§ 7-2-102 – 7-2-105 are amended to read as*
20 *follows:*

22 *(a) The First Congressional District shall be composed of:*
