8 TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING THE

16 TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION  
17 CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF FOREIGN  
18 LAWS, LEGAL CODES, OR SYSTEMS.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
22 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL  
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of  
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state  
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives  
28 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election  
29 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of  
30 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Senate Joint Resolution is to amend the  
33 Arkansas Constitution concerning the application of foreign laws, legal  
34 codes, or systems for the purpose of protecting rights and privileges granted  
35 under the United States Constitution and the Arkansas Constitution.
