20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
21 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 WHEREAS, Miss Alyse Eady, a native of Fort Smith, Arkansas, was chosen
24 in June 2010 as Miss Arkansas 2010, and narrowly missed becoming Miss America
25 2011, placing as 1st Runner-Up in the January 2011 pageant in Las Vegas,
26 Nevada, following her stellar performance in the talent competition as a
27 singer and ventriloquist; and

29 WHEREAS, Miss Eady graduated in May 2010 from Ouachita Baptist
30 University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Mass
31 Communications and Speech Communication; and

33 WHEREAS, during her four (4) years at Ouachita Baptist University, Miss
34 Eady was selected to be a Tiger Tunes Hostess, was a member of the EEE
35 Women's Social Club, participated in the Big Brothers/Big Sisters mentoring
36 program, worked in the admissions office as a student recruiter for the



1 university, and served on the Miss OBU Court of Honor; and

3 WHEREAS, Miss Eady spent part of her education studying abroad in
4 Spain, furthering her love of international travel; and

6 WHEREAS, while growing up in Fort Smith, Miss Eady was chosen as Youth
7 of the Year for the state of Arkansas by the Boys & Girls Clubs of America
8 (BGCA); and then was chosen Youth of the Year for the entire Southwest
9 Region, leading to opportunities that were life changing, including meeting
10 with President George W. Bush in the Oval Office and addressing Congress; and

12 WHEREAS, Miss Eady served as a BGCA ambassador to Turkey and Germany
13 and was honored by FreedomCorps as the "Volunteer of the Year" for three
14 thousand (3,000) hours of community service; and

16 WHEREAS, Miss Eady competed and won at the 2010 Miss Arkansas Pageant
17 as Miss South Central Arkansas and also won a Preliminary Talent Award and
18 the Coleman Overall Talent Award at the pageant; and

20 WHEREAS, Miss Eady has performed her variety act, in which she both
21 sings and does ventriloquism to the song "I Want to be a Cowboy's
22 Sweetheart", on television several times since last summer; and

24 WHEREAS, following her year of service as Miss Arkansas 2010, Miss Eady
25 plans to continue her education by pursuing an MBA,

27 NOW THEREFORE,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
29 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

31 THAT the Senate commends Miss Alyse Eady on her service to the State of
32 Arkansas, her selection as Miss Arkansas 2010, her selection as 1st Runner-Up
33 in the Miss America 2011 Pageant, and thanks her for her contributions to her
34 local community and the international community.
