22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
23 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

25 That Representative McLean is authorized to introduce a bill which, as
26 introduced, will read substantially as follows:

29 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ELECTED OFFICIALS SHALL RECEIVE MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT
30 AT THE SAME RATE AS STATE EMPLOYEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-903(b)(2), concerning mileage reimbursement, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(D) Constitutional and state elected officials and their employees shall receive mileage reimbursement at a rate not to exceed the rate established by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for state employees."
