28 Benton, Arkansas, where he served as a Deacon, a Sunday School teacher, a
29 Royal Ambassador Director, and as a member of many church committees; and he
30 was a Veteran of the United States Air Force; and

32 WHEREAS, Mr. Landers served in the House of Representatives of the
33 Arkansas General Assembly for thirty-two (32) years; and during his tenure at
34 the legislature, he served as Chair of the Legislative Council and Speaker of
35 the House; and



1 WHEREAS, Mr. Landers retired from Alcoa and Malvern National Bank; and
2 he worked on behalf of AEDD, Nursing Board of Arkansas, Community Bankers
3 Association, the Association of Rural Arkansas Telephone System, the Arkansas
4 School for the Deaf, and the Arkansas Health Center; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Landers was inducted into the Benton Athletic Memorial
7 Museum Wall Hall of Fame; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Landers was preceded in death by his parents; his brothers
10 and sisters, Ralph Landers, Vera Landers Lorenzo, Watt Landers, Carl Landers,
11 Lucy Landers Crawford, and Bob Landers; and a granddaughter, Lorie Black; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Landers is survived by his devoted wife of sixty (60)
14 years, Lea; two daughters, JoNell Mallory and husband Jim, and Lisa McGuire
15 and husband, Steve; three grandchildren, Mistie Black and her father, Bill
16 Black, Todd McGuire and wife, Meagan, and Brice McGuire; three great-
17 grandchildren, Laci Larsen, Luke Larsen, and Beckett McGuire; brother, Jim
18 Landers; sister, Mamie Landers Chisholm; John Landers, special nephew; and
