17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-60-102(a), concerning the definition of
20 "novelty lighter" is amended to read as follows:

21 (a)(1) As used in this section, "novelty lighter" means a product
22 commonly used by consumers to ignite cigarettes, cigars, ~~and~~ pipes, gas
23 grills, or other combustible material that has entertaining audio or visual
24 features that depict or resemble in physical form or function articles
25 commonly recognized as appealing to or intended for use by children ten (10)
26 years of age or younger, including without limitation lighters that depict or
27 resemble cartoon characters, toys, guns, watches, musical instruments,
28 vehicles, toy animals, food, or beverages, or that play musical notes or have
29 flashing lights or other entertaining features.

30 (2) "Novelty lighter" does not include:

- 31 (A) A lighter manufactured before 1980; or
32 (B) A lighter that lacks a device necessary to produce
33 combustion or a flame.
