21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL  
22 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL  
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

26 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of  
27 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state  
28 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives  
29 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election  
30 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of  
31 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

33 SECTION 1. This amendment shall be known and may be cited as "The  
34 Arkansas Elected Officials Ethics, Transparency, and Financial Reform  
35 Amendment of 2014."

1           SECTION 2. The purpose of this joint resolution is to amend the  
2 Arkansas Constitution concerning elected state officials, including without  
3 limitation ethics and service of elected state officials.
