16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
18 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

20 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
21 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
22 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
23 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
24 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
25 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

27 SECTION 1. This amendment shall be known and may be cited as the
28 "Arkansas Public Prayer Amendment".
29

30 SECTION 2. The purpose of this joint resolution is to amend the
31 Arkansas Constitution concerning freedom of religion.
