22 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Brenda Cluck was born in Russellville,
23 Arkansas, graduated from Russellville High School, and received a Bachelor of
24 Arts degree from Arkansas Tech University and a Master of Arts degree from
25 Webster University; and

27 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Cluck joined the Arkansas Army National
28 Guard in 1985 as a Private in the 217th Maintenance Battalion in Russellville;

31 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Cluck graduated from the Arkansas Military
32 Academy and received her commission in June of 1989 and was assigned to the
33 937th Signal Battalion in Fayetteville; and

35 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Cluck fulfilled numerous subsequent
36 assignments including Battery Commander of HHB 142nd Field Artillery Brigade,



1 Commander of Company D, 212th Signal Battalion, Operations Officer of the 25th
2 RTOC, and Executive Officer of 871st Troop Command; and

4 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Cluck was the first female to serve as
5 Aide-de-Camp to the Adjutant General; and

7 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Cluck deployed to Iraq with the 39th
8 Infantry Brigade from 2004-2005, and upon her return served in the Deputy
9 Chief of Staff, Personnel directorate which culminated in her assignment as
10 Deputy G1; and

12 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Cluck has served the past 2 years as the
13 Personnel Mobilization Branch Chief and full-time Joint Services Support
14 Branch Chief; and

16 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Cluck's military awards include receiving
17 the Combat Action Badge, the Meritorious Service Medal three times, the Army
18 Reserve Component Achievement Medal six times, the National Defense Service
19 Medal twice, the Joint Meritorious Unit Award, the Army Service Ribbon, the
20 Overseas Service Ribbon, the Armed Forces Reserve Medal with "M" Device, and
21 the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal,

23 NOW THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
