19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-203(14), concerning the definition of
22 "exempt commodities and services" in the Arkansas Procurement Law, is amended
23 to add three new subdivisions to read as follows:

24 (CC) Commodities and raw materials purchased by Arkansas
25 Correctional Industries intended for use in goods for resale;

26 (DD) Commodities purchased for crop production, including without
27 limitation fertilizers, seed, seedlings, and agricultural-related chemicals;

29 (EE) Repair services for hidden or unknown damages to
30 commodities already purchased;
