## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO INCLUDE VETERANS OF OPERATION URGENT FURY  
9 AS VETERANS ENTITLED TO A REDUCED-FEE SPECIAL LICENSE  
10 PLATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 TO INCLUDE VETERANS OF OPERATION URGENT  
15 FURY AS VETERANS ENTITLED TO A REDUCED-  
16 FEE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 24, Subchapter 2 is amended  
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 27-24-212. Veterans of Operation Urgent Fury.

24 (a) The Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to  
25 issue one (1) special license plate under this section to an applicant who  
26 establishes upon initial application that he or she is a veteran of the armed  
27 forces who served in Grenada during Operation Urgent Fury.

28 (b)(1) The department shall design the special license plates issued  
29 under this section according to § 27-24-209.

30 (2) In lieu of the legend "The Natural State" or any succeeding  
31 legend, there shall be placed across the bottom of the license plate a  
32 permanent decal bearing the words "Operation Urgent Fury".

33 (c) A veteran of the armed forces who served in Grenada during  
34 Operation Urgent Fury may apply for and annually renew a special license  
35 plate issued under this section as provided under § 27-24-206 (a) and (b).

36 (d) Upon the initial application for a special license plate issued



1 under this section, a veteran of the armed forces who served in Grenada  
2 during Operation Urgent Fury shall provide adequate proof to the department  
3 that he or she meets the requirements of this section.

4 (e) The registration of a special license plate under this section may  
5 continue from year to year as long as it is renewed each year within the time  
6 and in the manner required by law.

8 *SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after January*  
9 *1, 2014.*
