16 THE ARKANSAS ELECTED OFFICIALS ETHICS,

18 AMENDMENT OF 2014.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
22 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
28 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
29 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
30 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. This amendment shall be known and may be cited as "The
33 Arkansas Elected Officials Ethics, Transparency, and Financial Reform
34 Amendment of 2014."

36 SECTION 2. The purpose of this joint resolution is to amend the



1 Arkansas Constitution concerning elected state officials, including without
2 limitation ethics and service of elected state officials.
