20 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Little Rock is entering its ninety-first
21 year of service to the community of Little Rock; has a mission of “promoting
22 volunteerism, developing the potential of women, and improving the community
23 through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers”; is
24 comprised of over 1,200 dynamic women who represent a diverse group; and
25 includes a membership of medical professionals, attorneys, media
26 personalities, teachers, decision-makers in a variety of businesses and non-
27 profit organizations, public officials, community volunteers, and civic
28 leaders; and

30 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Little Rock, whose purpose is exclusively
31 educational and charitable, is committed to volunteerism and recognizes the
32 critical role of the voluntary sector and thereby works to improve our
33 community through providing volunteers, training, funding, and leadership
34 support; and

36 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Little Rock recognizes that the future of



1 every community lies with its children; is committed to ensuring that
2 children have the opportunities, services, and protection essential for their
3 physical, intellectual, emotional, and social growth; and promotes the
4 protection and empowerment of children, the health, education, and welfare of
5 women, and the support and education of parents; and

7 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Little Rock's membership has contributed
8 91 years of volunteer service to improving the Little Rock community, and is
9 currently focusing efforts in the next 10 years of service on creating
10 meaningful change to improve health and wellness and school preparedness,
11 including efforts to increase literacy and to promote better nutrition,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
15 STATE OF ARKANSAS:
