19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Uncodified Acts 2013, No. 1171, § 6 is amended to read as
22 follows:

23 SECTION 6. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. Legislative Arkansas
24 Blue Ribbon Committee on Local 911 Systems – Expiration.

25 The Legislative Arkansas Blue Ribbon Committee on Local 911 Systems
26 expires on ~~January 1, 2015~~ January 1, 2017.

28 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
29 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Legislative Arkansas Blue
30 Ribbon Committee on Local 911 Systems expires on January 1, 2015; that the
31 Legislative Arkansas Blue Ribbon Committee on Local 911 Systems needs to
32 continue to study the impact of 911 emergency service to protect the lives,
33 health, and welfare of the state's residents in emergency situations,
34 specifically in rural areas of the state; that the Legislative Arkansas Blue
35 Ribbon Committee on Local 911 Systems should be extended immediately in order
36 to continue its mission and that this act is necessary to enhance the



1 benefits of the 911 emergency system to all residents of this state.
2 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately
3 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
4 become effective on:

5 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

6 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
7 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
8 bill; or

9 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
10 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
