9 TESTING OF HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS; AND FOR OTHER
10 PURPOSES.

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14 TO REPEAL PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW THAT
15 REQUIRE TESTING OF HOME-SCHOOLED
16 STUDENTS.

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-504 is amended to read as follows:

22 6-15-504. ~~Home-schooled students—Achievement tests—~~ Enrollment or
23 reenrollment in local schools.

24 ~~(a) Each student enrolled in a home school program who is considered~~
25 ~~to be at grade level or no more than two (2) years beyond the normal age for~~
26 ~~the appropriate grade for which the state mandates norm-referenced tests for~~
27 ~~public school students shall be tested using a nationally recognized norm-~~
28 ~~referenced achievement test selected by the State Board of Education.~~

29 ~~(b)(1)(A) The administration of the tests required of home-schooled~~
30 ~~students shall be by the executive directors of the education service~~
31 ~~cooperatives established under The Education Service Cooperative Act of 1985,~~
32 ~~§ 6-13-1001 et seq., or as otherwise designated by the Department of~~
33 ~~Education.~~

34 ~~(B) For the purposes of this section, the superintendents~~
35 ~~of the Little Rock School District, North Little Rock School District, and~~
36 ~~Pulaski County Special School District shall act in lieu of an education~~



1 ~~service cooperative executive director.~~

2 ~~(2) The executive directors of the education service~~
 3 ~~cooperatives shall establish a common set of procedures approved by the~~
 4 ~~Commissioner of Education for the proper administration of the tests required~~
 5 ~~by this section.~~

6 ~~(3) The administration shall include purchasing the test~~
 7 ~~materials, giving the tests, scoring and interpreting the tests, and~~
 8 ~~reporting test results.~~

9 ~~(c) The cost of testing required by this section shall be the~~
 10 ~~responsibility of the department when the tests are administered by the~~
 11 ~~directors of the education service cooperatives or other department~~
 12 ~~designees.~~

13 ~~(d)(1) Alternate testing procedures may be approved by the executive~~
 14 ~~director of an education service cooperative after consultation with the~~
 15 ~~parents of a home-schooled student.~~

16 ~~(2) However, any costs associated with an alternate testing~~
 17 ~~procedure shall be the responsibility of the parents.~~

18 ~~(e)(1)(A) Any student who refuses to participate in the testing~~
 19 ~~program or the alternate testing program required by this section has not met~~
 20 ~~the statutory prerequisites for home schooling and, as any other student,~~
 21 ~~shall be subject to the applicable Arkansas laws regarding truancy.~~

22 ~~(B) After a student corrects any refusal to participate in~~
 23 ~~the testing program or the alternate testing program as determined by the~~
 24 ~~department and required by this subsection, the student shall be restored to~~
 25 ~~home school status after his or her parent or guardian has complied with all~~
 26 ~~requirements of § 6-15-503.~~

27 ~~(2) This subsection shall not be applicable to any parent who~~
 28 ~~can present written acknowledgement that the child has been enrolled in a~~
 29 ~~public, private, or parochial school within thirty (30) days of the~~
 30 ~~administration of the state-mandated achievement test.~~

31 ~~(f)(1)(a)(1)~~ Each local school district may assess any home-schooled
 32 student who enrolls or reenrolls in the school district in order to determine
 33 proper educational placement.

34 (2) Among other means of assessment, the local school district
 35 shall utilize the norm-referenced test approved by the state board to assess
 36 the student and shall determine placement in the appropriate grade level as

1 ~~indicated by the test results~~ A local school district that chooses to assess
2 a home-school student who enrolls or reenrolls in the school district shall
3 use the same assessment that the school district uses when a student who has
4 attended another public school or private school enrolls or reenrolls.

5 ~~(g)(b)~~ Any A home-schooled student who enrolls or reenrolls in a local
6 school district ~~must~~ shall attend classes for at least nine (9) months
7 immediately before graduation before the student can become eligible to
8 receive a high school diploma from the school district.

9 (c) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a home-schooled student
10 from participating in any test or assessment.

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
