15 CONCERNING SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-426(f) and (g), concerning school
21 improvement, are amended to read as follows:

22 (f) ~~(1)~~ The comprehensive school improvement plan shall+

23 ~~(1) Be~~ be based on an analysis of student performance data and
24 other relevant data that provide a plan of action to address deficiencies in
25 student performance and any academic achievement gap evidenced in the
26 Arkansas Comprehensive Testing, Assessment, and Accountability Program; ~~and.~~

27 (2) ~~Include~~ The comprehensive school improvement plan shall
28 include a general description of the public school or school district's use
29 of categorical funding for:

30 (A) Alternative learning environments;

31 (B) Professional development;

32 (C) English-language learners; and

33 (D) National school lunch students, as defined by § 6-20-
34 2303(12)(A).

35 (g) Any public school or school district classified as in school
36 improvement under § 6-15-425 shall, with the assistance of the department,



1 develop and file with the department a revised comprehensive school
 2 improvement plan meeting the requirements of this section and containing any
 3 additional requirements determined necessary by the department to ensure that
 4 all students in the public school or school district have an opportunity to
 5 demonstrate proficiency on all portions of the state-mandated assessments.
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7 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-15-426(i)(1)(A) and (B), concerning
 8 school improvement, are repealed.

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30 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-15-2202(b)(1)(B), concerning National
 31 School Lunch Act funds and national school lunch student state categorical
 32 funds in a school improvement plan, is repealed.
