## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ARKANSAS HIGHWAY POLICE DIVISION  
9 OF THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION  
10 DEPARTMENT TO UTILIZE THE AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE  
11 READER SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO ALLOW THE ARKANSAS HIGHWAY POLICE  
16 DIVISION OF THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY  
17 AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO UTILIZE  
18 THE AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE READER  
19 SYSTEM.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1803 is amended to read as follows:  
25 12-12-1803. Restrictions on use.

26 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, it is  
27 unlawful for an individual, partnership, corporation, association, or the  
28 State of Arkansas, its agencies, and political subdivisions to use an  
29 automatic license plate reader system.

30 (b) An automatic license plate reader system may be used:

31 (1) By a state, county, or municipal law enforcement agency for  
32 the comparison of captured plate data with data held by the Office of Motor  
33 Vehicle, the Arkansas Crime Information Center, the National Crime  
34 Information Center, a database created by law enforcement for the purposes of  
35 an ongoing investigation, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation for any  
36 lawful purpose;



1           (2) By parking enforcement entities for regulating the use of  
2 parking facilities; or

3           (3) For the purpose of controlling access to secured areas;

4           (4) By the Arkansas Highway Police Division of the Arkansas  
5 State Highway and Transportation Department for electronic verification of  
6 registration, logs, and other compliance data to provide more efficient  
7 movement of commercial vehicles on state highways; and

8           (5) By the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department  
9 for survey and research purposes.
