25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 120, Subchapter 1, is*
28 *amended to add an additional section to read as follows:*

29 16-120-106. Limitation of liability for local law enforcement
30 agencies.

31 A local law enforcement agency has tort immunity for any act by an
32 employee of the local law enforcement agency who is a certified law
33 enforcement officer that occurs while the employee is working for a third
34 party outside of the:

35 (1) Employee's normal working hours; or

36 (2) Scope of the employee's employment with the local law
