1 WHEREAS, the Arkansas Run for the Fallen 5K begins at 1:40 PM on
2 Sunday, March 22, 2015, where participants will join a core team of runners
3 for the final 3 miles of their 146 mile run and arrive at the steps of the
4 Arkansas State Capitol at approximately 2:10 PM; and
