26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
27

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-208(i), concerning fees for
29 applications for permits to sell vinous (except small farm wines),
30 spirituous, or malt liquor, is amended to read as follows:

31 (i) (1) There shall be an initial application fee of ~~two thousand~~
32 ~~dollars (\$2,000)~~ ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

33 (2) If an applicant is successful in his or her application,
34 eight thousand four hundred dollars (\$8,400) of that sum shall be refunded.

35 (3) In the event If an applicant is not successful in his or her
36 application, one thousand dollars (\$1,000) nine thousand three hundred



1 dollars (\$9,300) of that sum shall be refunded.
